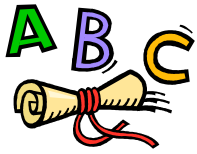

**Classroom:** As a Resource Specialist Program (RSP) teacher, Mary teaches students with different learning abilities as described in their Individual Education Program. Using a research-based core curriculum in both a push-in and pull-out format, Mary modifies instruction to support the educational needs of children with IEPs as well as children who are at-risk.

**Activities:** Mary is a member of the School Site Council and supports the goals and objectives of the Visitacion Valley Elementary School Academic Plan including the implementation of the research-based reading curriculum, improving student writing performance and closing the achievement gap of our African-American and Latino students. Mary is part of a team of teachers developing and implementing Family Math Nights as well as school-wide professional development for writing instruction. Mary is a member of the Interagency Coordinated Care team that monitors and supports at-risk children.
