## **School Board President in Stable Condition**

San Francisco School Board President Norman Yee is recovering in the hospital after being struck by a car on Tuesday evening, December 26, 2006. Mr. Yee was walking at the intersection of 4<sup>th</sup> and Bryant Streets in San Francisco when he was hit by a car.

Norman Yee's family wishes to thank members of the San Francisco community for their concern and good wishes. According to family members, Mr. Yee's condition is presently stable and is not life-threatening. He is under excellent medical care and is following his doctor's instructions.

Family members respectfully request privacy as they concentrate on supporting his recovery.

Commissioner Yee was elected to the San Francisco Board of Education in November of 2004. He has dedicated the last 30 years of his life working in education. He served as the Executive Director for the Wu Yee Children's Services and as a fellow for the Annie E. Casey Foundation for Children and Family Leadership. Norman Yee lends his expertise to a number of educational organizations, including the Parent Services Projects, the California Infant and Toddler Development Learning Guidelines Taskforce, and is co-founder of the San Francisco Child Care Providers Association. Mr. Yee also served as a consultant to the Asian and Pacific Islanders California Action Network (APIsCAN) in the area of universal preschool. In 1997, Mr. Yee was awarded the Local Hero award by AT&T and the Week of the Young Child Award by the SF Child Care Planning and Advisory Council in 2003.
